

HUMC Reopening Team
Volunteer Recruitment & Training Report
Aug. 10, 2020

New volunteers coming into the rotation and will have training session this Thursday at 7:00

- We are thankful to have Dawn, Kathleen and Ruth Ann join our Volunteer Lead rotation to ensure there is sufficient coverage for every Sunday
- Decision: We are proposing eliminating the Bathroom attendant role, which is not a requirement of the conference guidelines, as follows:
 - o Conference requirement is to disinfect surfaces every 15 min to 2 hours which can be done without the attendant
 - o Allows us to place volunteers in roles where they feel they are contributing and can still attend worship
 - o Propose using Velcro signage on doors for “occupied” and “vacant” for worshipers to use to maintain 1 person at a time
 - o Request new signage be placed on bathroom doors advising folks to knock first and only 1 at a time (in addition to vacant/occupied in the event people do not switch the sign) – this would require keeping the sanctuary door closed next to the pulpit to avoid noise traveling into the sanctuary
- Lessons learned:
 - o Keep sanctuary doors closed to help manage groups entering and keep temperature cool in the lobby - the “floater” will be the only one opening the door (and floater will open the doors before worshipers leave the service)
